for kids, as well as discounts or free merchandise coupons to stores for the parents! Parents and kids hunt for eggs throughout the district!

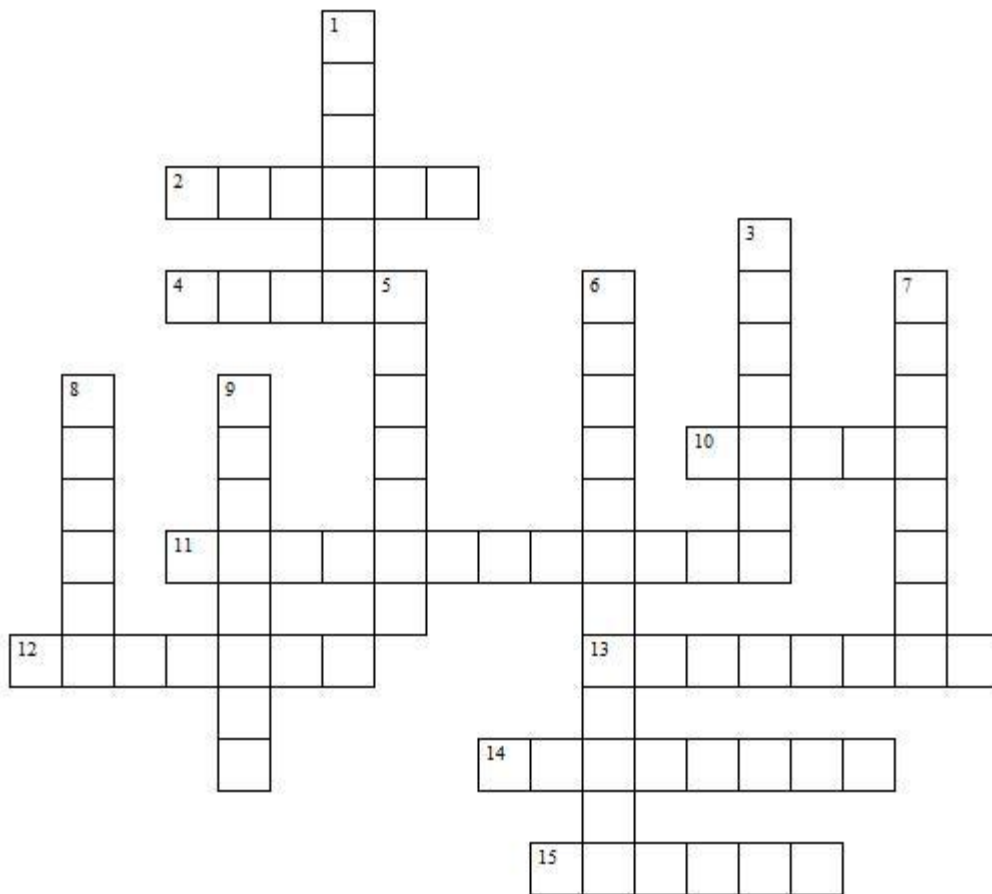
The fun starts at 7pm sharp!
